



OUT WITH THE OLD - HONDA INTRODUCES A NEW LINE OF CRUISERS

Abbotsford, B.C. – Honda is riding into 2010 with a fresh look for its cruiser line with the introduction of the VT1300 Series replacing the tried and true VTX1300 line that was introduced in 2006. The new series – the Sabre, Interstate and Stateline – join the previously launched Fury and will be debuted in British Columbia at the Vancouver Motorcycle Show, January 22-25 at TRADEX in Abbotsford.

While the VT1300CX/VT1300CXA Fury and Fury ABS are sure to turn heads with they're long wheelbase and high mount steering head, you've got to believe that the five position spring pre-load on the single shock rear suspension of the factory customs paired with the extended 45 mm front fork are the real show stopper.

Not to be outdone, the three new additions to the 1300 line burst out of the gate with some serious attributes of their own.

Take, for instance, the throaty rumble of the V-Twin on the VT1300CRA Stateline ABS. The look and feel of this bike is a serious throwback to the days of easy riding with its retro styled pullback handle bar and speedometer positioned in tank mounted chrome housing.

For those who are looking to hit the road and cover some serious countryside, the VT1300CT Interstate offers up a full widescreen, floorboards and exclusive leather wrapped hard saddlebags with a 1300 V-Twin that provides ample low-end and mid-range torque to give you the power you need at any altitude.

With a low narrow handlebar set forward for an aggressive riding position and a ranked-out front end, the VT1300CT Sabre looks like it's on the attack. Trimmed back front and rear fenders and a one-piece seat create a minimalist look that only adds to the sleek aggressive aura of this mechanical beast.

The latest and greatest from the world of motorcycles are on display at the 2010 Vancouver Motorcycle Show, running January 21 – 24 at TRADEX in Abbotsford. Admission is \$12.00 for adults, \$8.00 for youth (6-15), free for children (under 6) and \$32.00 for families (two adults, two youth).
